

Guidelines for Municipal Waste Disposal in Paju







Municipal Waste Collection Day and Disposal Location

Collection Day	Monday - Saturday (No collection on Sundays and public holidays)
Disposal Time	From 6:00 p.m. the evening before the collection day – To 5:00 a.m. on the collection day
Disposal Location	Main road in front of residence

Where to Purchase Authorized Garbage Bags

Available at nearby supermarkets, convenience stores, etc.

Municipal Waste Collection Day and Disposal Location

General Waste	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> General waste must be disposed of in authorized white or green garbage bags 	
Food Waste	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Multi-family housing: Food waste must be disposed of in a designated collection bin (using RFID systems) Detached housing: Food waste must be disposed of in yellow authorized garbage bags 	
Recyclables	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recyclable items such as cans, bottles, glass, and Styrofoam must be sorted by type and disposed of in clear bags Recyclables contaminated with foreign substances must be disposed of as general waste in authorized garbage bags 	
Non-Combustible Waste	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Non-combustible waste includes ceramics, broken glass, cat litter, tiles, flower pots, and other non-burnable waste. It must be disposed of in authorized non-combustible waste bags (yellow PP bags) 	
Large-sized Waste	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Large-sized waste includes furniture, bedding, bags, bicycles, etc. Purchase the appropriate large-sized waste disposal sticker for the item, place the sticker on the item, and dispose of the waste <p>* Payment Information: Scan the QR code</p>	 

Using Authorized Garbage Bags is Mandatory!

Illegal dumping of waste is subject to a fine of up to KRW 1 million.

Waste not separated as above or not placed in authorized garbage bags will not be collected .

Waste Disguised as Recyclables

Place in Authorized Garbage Bags

1. Containers from Which Foreign Substances Cannot Be Removed Even After Rinsing

Greaseproof Paper in Chicken Boxes

- Heavily soiled with foreign substances and mixed with different materials, making recycling



Unrinsed Instant Rice Cups, Cup Noodle Containers

- Mixed with different materials, making recycling difficult
- Unrinsed cup noodle containers have residual food, making recycling difficult



Mayonnaise, Ketchup, and Oil Containers with Food Residue

- Can be recycled if properly rinsed and dried



2. Items Not for Separate Disposal Easy To Misread

Fruit Nets and Packaging

- Difficult to recycle



Broken Bottles, Flat Glass, and Lighting Fixture Glass

- Broken bottles and flat glass are difficult to recycle ▷ Wrap in newspaper, then dispose of



Ceramics and Porcelain Dishes

- Difficult to recycle ▷ Dispose of as non-combustible waste



Ice Packs

- Dispose of in authorized garbage bags as ice packs made of super absorbent polymers are difficult to recycle (separate for disposal if dedicated collection bins are available).



Thermal Insulation Bags

- Difficult to recycle



Stationary Items [Ballpoint pens, Mechanical Pencils, Toothbrushes, etc.]

- Mixed with different materials, making recycling difficult



CD/DVD, Rubber Gloves, Slippers

- Mixed with different materials, making recycling difficult



Rope

- Difficult to sort as materials composing ropes vary by type, making recycling difficult



Diapers and Tissues

- Difficult to recycle



3. Waste Vinyl Remove foreign substances by emptying contents and rinsing with water before separate disposal

Vinyl with Food Residue

- If unable to rinse, dispose of in authorized garbage bags



Vinyl with Stickers Attached

- If foreign substances cannot be removed, dispose of in authorized garbage bags



Non-Recyclables

- Tablecloths, aluminium foil, duvet covers, etc., must be disposed of in authorized garbage bags.
